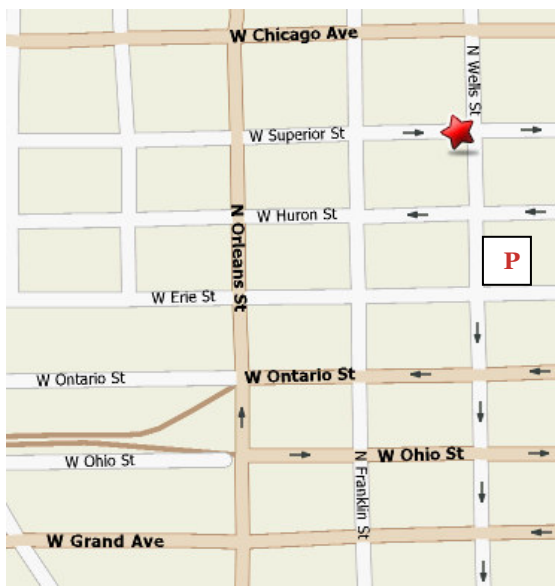
### AUDIENCE

### FORMAT/STRUCTURE

No formal preparation or powerpoint presentation is required. Suggested agenda:

3. Current Strategic opportunities/challenges – 10 minutes
4. Current favorite business/leadership reading – 5 minutes
6. Q&A – 15 minutes



In the past, some have spent the first Q&A session asking the group about the i.c.stars program. The middle part is spent talking about your career and business/technology strategy or a leadership development topic. The last part is for participant questions. This structure changes for each individual depending on their style/preferences.
